Brief Narrative

I have been living out my Deacon's call by serving as Pastor of Congregational Care for Grace United Methodist Church and serving currently as a full-time hospice Chaplain (non-appointment). Through prayer, teaching, sacramental assistance and administration, leadership of the Care Team, and relational outreach, I seek to offer Christ-centered compassion to all members. A significant aspect of my ministry as a Deacon involves direct relational engagement with congregation members. Responsibilities include:

- Making regular care calls to offer support, encouragement, and spiritual listening.
- Conducting home visits for individuals experiencing illness, bereavement, life transitions, or isolation.
- Collaborating with the care team and the pastoral staff to ensure continuity of care and follow-up as needed.

I have taught a 4-week course on the Basics of Process Theology and preached in worship on a quarterly basis to fulfill my call to teaching and proclaiming the Word.

I feel especially called to walk beside those who have daily struggles, which include facilitating a Caregiver Support Group which meets monthly. It is my strong belief that we serve the world by showing compassion and care to those who cross our paths inside and outside of the church walls.

- -Enquire about the need for a Grief Support Group
- -To further develop our prayer vigils and times of community prayer praying for the needs of the Church and the world which can bring awareness to the great needs.
